Daitari-Banspani is 155 km long new railway line project. This line connects the Banspani and Daitari iron ore sectors of Orissa with Paradeep Port via a route which will be shorter by 335 km. than the route via Kharagpur. This makes the Iron Ore from Orissa more competitive in the international market. Many major steel plants are coming up in Kalinga Nagar Industrial Complex in Daitari area. This alignment serves these steel plants both for receipt of their raw materials and dispatch of the finished products.

Progress of Work

- i) Banspani – Keonjhar Section: – Goods traffic is in operation by S.E.Railway since August, 2004.
- ii) Keonjhar – Tomka: – All works completed and goods trains started plying since 25.03.2007 and passenger trains since 04.01.2009.
- iii) Daitari (Tomka) – Keonjhar: - Completed.
- iv) 1st Passenger train (8416) on Jakhapura-Daitari line has been flagged off by Chairman, Railway Board on 04.01.2009.
- v) Fly Over Works between Jakhapura-Sukinda Road (9.2Km) –
(a) Railway Board has approved proposal for twin single line working between Jakhapura and Sukinda Road. (b) All Civil Engg. Works completed. The Fly Over Line will be commissioned along with S&T and OHE works after getting CRS sanction for Twin Single Working.
